From Pesos and Pounds to Euros and Yen, Sage Accpac Multi-Currency provides automated currency conversion while allowing you to maintain an unlimited number of currencies and rate types. Sage Accpac also supports up to 3 decimal places and 18 digits (15 before and 3 after the decimal - more than most competing accounting products offer!). And with a centralized table of all exchange rates, you can use the power of automation to keep track of ever-changing currency valuation.

Local and Regional Preferences

The development team for Sage Accpac is also mindful of various regional settings that include things like date preferences (mm/dd/yy vs. dd/mm/yy), characters used for number formatting (decimal vs. comma), currency symbols and much more. And when it comes to localization, the configuration options and flexibility of Sage Accpac can accommodate the nuances of almost any jurisdiction. So rather than providing Australian, Canadian, and American versions of Accpac to accommodate the respective sales tax laws, Accpac is available in one version that boasts a sales tax engine that's powerful enough to tackle just about any local sales tax law you'll encounter.

Looking Ahead to Version 6

There's a lot of buzz around the anticipated release of Sage Accpac ERP Version 6 in December 2010. Most notably, Version 6 marks the beginning of Sage Accpac's transition from a traditional Windows desktop application to a true web application with a browser-based interface. Let's take a quick look ahead at the exciting changes coming your way.

New User Interface and Web Portal

One of the main features of Version 6 is a fancy new **Web Portal** that replaces your desktop home page. The new portal is the first step in migrating Sage Accpac to a webbased application and is built around the principle of "User Centered Design." That means Sage Accpac recognizes your role in the company, replacing the tree of icons you see now with a dashboard of information useful for doing **your** job. The ultimate goal is to help you find what you need faster. Rest assured, you'll still have the option of running the classic desktop until you're comfortable making the switch.

Reporting and Inquiries

Sometimes it's a challenge to get data out of Accpac and into a report or inquiry in the **exact way** that you want to see it. If you find that Crystal Reports is too complex to use on your own (without IT support), then you'll love the new **Adhoc Query** in Accpac 6. This simple yet powerful tool allows you to choose, sort, and sum the exact data you want without technical knowledge or Crystal Report training.

Improved SageCRM Integration

Since SageCRM is already a fully web-based application, the migration of Accpac 6 to the web means that the integration between your front and back office (via Extended Enterprise Suite) will be tighter than ever. That way, a sales person won't know whether he/she is looking at SageCRM or Accpac, making it easier to create quotes, orders, and turn leads into new customers. Tighter integration also ensures the workflow is continuous and the data is automatically synchronized in both directions.

Most Popular Customer-Requested Feature

Sage Accpac 6 will introduce the ability to **Lock Fiscal Periods by Module**. That means modules can now be locked down until the fiscal period closing has been completed, preventing unwanted postings into the wrong fiscal period. This was the most <u>popular customer-requested feature</u> based on customers like YOU that voted online at the <u>Sage Accpac</u> Ideas website.

WHAT DOES CRM HAVE TO DO WITH ME?

Accounting Staff

Your accounting staff probably gets multiple requests every week from sales and customer service regarding status of orders, shipments, credit lines, payments received, and endless other accounting and operational inquiries. With Extended Enterprise Suite, all that information is centralized

in the same database. That means sales personnel can use SageCRM to perform their own operational inquiries while Accounting benefits from fewer daily interruptions. In fact, sales staff can use the SageCRM desktop to enter quotes and orders directly into Sage Accpac, further reducing the administrative burden on your accounting department.
